

Boarding Policy

Partners in pet health



We offer boarding services to our clients for those times your pet(s) cannot be with you. All animals are kept inside in order to provide climate control. Dogs are walked in an exercise enclosure by an attendant. We encourage you to bring any special items pets may need (please label them), and it is always a good idea to provide their normal diet, especially if they are on prescription food. We do feed Purina Proplan as the kennel diet. You may drop your pet off or discharge them at anytime during business hours. Reservations are required, and it is necessary to make them well in advance at holiday time. We do require that pets be current on their immunizations, have had a negative stool specimen on their most recent exam within the last year, and that they be checked for external parasites while in the facility. We do need to depopulate fleas and ticks if found! There may be a small fee for this service. Boarding fees are incurred by the night, check out time is 12 noon. We do permit discharge on Sunday-but no holidays-for your convenience; discharge hours are strictly from 4:30pm-5:00pm on Sunday. We gladly administer medication to our pet guests while they are boarding, and the cost for this service is a minimal additional one to the boarding fee.
