

The canine first aid kit should contain:

Gloves
Thermometer (rectal, digital)
KY jelly
Tweezers
Scissors (small, sharp)
Newspapers (that can be rolled to form a splint)
Syringe(s)/dropper
Rubbing alcohol
Ice pack
Contact lens solution
Ear wash (may use 1 part vinegar in 5 parts water)
Peroxide
Neosporin plus
Cortisone cream
Kotex Pads
Ace bandage/"Cling" bandage
1 inch white tape
Gauze sponges
Cotton balls
Sock(s) of appropriate size
Benadryl tablets
Baby aspirin/prescription anti-inflammatory
Superglue
Pepto-Bismol tablets
Imodium tablets
Metamucil
Mineral oil
Towel or blanket
Baby wipes
Ziploc baggie(s)
Extra slip leash (may turn into harness)
Water Bowl

Doses and uses of products should be on the advice of a veterinarian!
